

HORSES RING SECTION

COMPETITORS MUST COMPLY WITH CURRENT DPI REQUIREMENTS

Regulations:

- **Judges Decision is Final.** Protests and complaints received by Secretary on the day of the Show. Protests to be made within 1/2 hour after Ticket of Award is issued accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which will be forfeited if proved frivolous.
- It is the condition of entry at this show that all horses and their handlers and /or riders competing, compete on the understanding that drug testing may be carried out.
- An Official Measurer will be on the ground. If any disputes, horses must be measured by appointed measurer. EFA official Height Certificates are accepted.
- Competitors entering in events which clash must supply another rider. Rings will not wait for competitors in other classes. Please see ring stewards or ring Horse Convenor.
- No person other than Judges, Committeemen, Stewards, Riders and Drivers of exhibits allowed inside Ring during Show Days.
- Stallions cannot compete in Hacking and Riding Classes, Special Classes accepted.
- Any alterations to programme will be posted on the Horse Notice Board at the Marshalling Yards. Competitors are requested to keep watching the Notice Board.
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to ascertain the time scheduled for his/her events and be ready. Competitors who are late may be refused entry to the Ring.
- Committee reserves the right the alter, delete / add to programme.
- All competitors in horse events must wear approved helmets.
- **Open Hacks are not eligible for showhunter classes and showhunter classes are not eligible for open hack classes.**
- 3rd place prizemoney will only be paid if there are 4 or more competitors in a class.
- **Novice Hack** - one which has never been awarded First place at any recognised Show in a similar event.
- **Intermediate Hack** - one which has never been awarded First, Second or Third at any Royal Show or awarded Champion Open Hack at a Qualifier or H.O.T.Y
- **No vehicles shall be permitted to park anywhere on the grounds without the relevant sticker.**
- **District Horse and rider must live within the Gunnedah Shire for 1 month prior to the show. Proof maybe required.**
- **Ruling for AHHA Classes:** To compete in any Australian Hunter Horse Association (AHHA) Members Class the Rider MUST be a current financial Member with AHHA. Winners of AHHA Members Classes are eligible to Enter their respective championship classes. Champion Hunter Pony, Hunter Galloway and Hunter Hack are eligible to Enter the Champion of Champions to be Held Saturday 3rd June 2017 for further details please visit the Australian Hunter Horse Association website
