Purpose: To confirm that the horse demonstrates correct basics, by showing suppleness both laterally and longitudinally, moving freely forward in a clear rhythm with a steady tempo ad readily accepting contact with the bit. Correct geometry and lines of travel should be shown.

Introduces: Working trot, working canter, free walk, 20m circles in trot and canter

Instructions: To be ridden in a snaffle. All trot work may be sitting or rising unless otherwise stated. Transitions may be progressive
