GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Members of the Gunnedah Show Society, upon production of their current membership card, will be admitted free to the Society's Annual Show.
2. COVID-19 Rules must be adhered to and the Gunnedah Show Society reserve the right to deny entry or ask people to leave if rules are not followed. This is to ensure a safe and enjoyable show for all.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any clause, condition, event or class in the programme and its decision in all cases shall be final.
4. Disrespect and/or verbal abuse towards Officials, Judges or Workers **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** and will result in disqualification from competition at the Gunnedah Show and will be asked to leave the showgrounds.
5. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the committee will not be responsible for any losses damage or faults. All persons / organizations compete / exhibit at their own risk, notwithstanding the existence or otherwise of a signed entry / nomination form.
6. No late entries will be accepted except under the discretion of sectional convenor. The decision of the Judge will be final except where a protest or complaint in writing is lodged with the Secretary on the ground on the day of the show within three hours after notice of award has been issued. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which may be forfeited if protest is found to be frivolous. All protests and complaints will be dealt with by the disputes committee from whose decision there shall be no appeal.
7. **NO VEHICLE SHALL BE PERMITTED TO PARK ANYWHERE ON THE GROUND WITHOUT THE RELEVANT STICKER.**
8. See Other Sections for Regulations and Conditions relating to their particular sections.
9. Perpetual Trophies will be presented to the winner and immediately returned.

NB: No perpetual trophies will leave the Gunnedah Showground.

GENERAL REGULATIONS CONTINUED

9. Competitors should be aware that in the case of quarantine lockdown, the owner is responsible for his/her own and his/her animal welfare and all costs incurred.
10. Drug Testing may be carried out at this show. Any competitor, owner or exhibitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly. Any penalty imposed as a result of an infringement will be fully supported by the Gunnedah Show Society.
11. Photo's taken at the Gunnedah Show may be used for future publicity.
12. Prizemoney not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.
13. Please register your livestock movements on the NILS data base. The Gunnedah Showground PIC is NA508076
14. No electrical tape or rope to be used anywhere on the showground to fence livestock in.
15. All electrical appliances, cables and gas bottles must be tagged, stamped, in date and covered.

Conditions: All entries must be received at the Wool Pavilion Saturday 10th April between 9am and 12 noon - Thursday 27th March between 9am and 10am. Arrangements to collect fleeces are made with the Convenor. All fleeces must have been grown by the exhibitor. All merino fleeces exhibited from flocks over 2000 are deemed to be in the Open Section. Further, all merino fleeces exhibited of a merino ram fleece are deemed to be in the Open Section. All fleeces must be skirted. Ram fleeces are excluded from Highest Commercial Value Trophy. All fleeces will be judged on point score basis laid down by the National Council of Woollselling Brokers. The Most Successful Exhibitor is calculated on a point score for each class: 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point, in classes with up to 7 entries. If there are 8 or more entries in a class: 1st 4 points, 2nd 3 points, 3rd, 2 points, 4th 1 point.
