

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 1. Members of the Gunnedah Show Society, upon production of their membership ticket, will be admitted to the Society's Annual Show.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any clause, condition, event or class in the programme and its decision in all cases shall be final.
- 3. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the committee will not be responsible for any losses damage or faults. All persons / organizations compete / exhibit at their own risk, not-withstanding the existence or otherwise of a signed entry / nomination form.
- 4. No late entries will be accepted except under the discretion of sectional convenor.
- 5. The decision of the **Judge will be final** except where a protest or complaint in writing is lodged with the Secretary on the ground on the day of the show within three hours after notice of award has been issued.
- 6. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which may be forfeited if protest is found to be frivolous. All protests and complaints will be dealt with by the disputes committee from whose decision there shall be no appeal.
- 7. See Other Sections for Regulations and Conditions relating to their particular sections.
- 8. Perpetual Trophies will be presented to the winner and immediately returned.

NO VEHICLE SHALL BE PERMITTED TO PARK ANYWHERE ON THE GROUND WITHOUT THE RELEVANT STICKER.

No perpetual trophies will leave the Gunnedah Showground.

GENERAL REGULATIONS CONTINED

- 9. Competitors should be aware that in the case of quarantine lockdown, the owner is responsible for his/her own and his/her animal welfare and all costs incurred.
- 10. Drug Testing may be carried out at this show. Any competitor, owner or exhibitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly. Any penalty imposed as a result of an infringement will be fully supported by the Gunnedah Show Society.
- 11. Photo's taken at the Gunnedah Show may be used for future publicity.
- 12. PIC Numbers people with horses on their property need to apply for a Property Identification Code this is a bio-security measure. PIC's are assigned to individual properties and allocated by Livestock Health and Pest Authorities who maintain a register. You may already have a PIC if you pay your rates to LPHA. Forms can be submitted on line through www.lhpa.org.au. Every exhibitor bringing horses to the show will be required to list each horse being shown together with the PIC for the property from which it has come on the Waiver form before competing.
- 13. No lunging on the Longmuir fields or tying of horses to floats or main arena.
- 14. No electrical tape or rope to be used anywhere on the showground to fence horses in.
- 15. All electrical appliances, cables and gas bottles must be tagged, stamped, in date and covered.

DEFINITIONS:

Riders age to be as at 1st day of competition.

District horse and rider must live within the Gunnedah shire for 1 month prior to the show. Proof maybe required.

Novice Hack - one which has never been awarded First place at any recognised Show in a similar event.

Intermediate Hack - one which has never been awarded First, Second or Third at any Royal Show, Horse of the Year Show or Qualifier in Open Hack classes only.

Stallion and Colts may only compete in classes where specifically permitted.

Stallions are not allowed to compete in Hack or Riding classes.

Open Hacks not eligible to compete in Showhunter classes

Showhunters not eligible to compete in Open Hack classes

PRIZEMONEY

All prizemoney not claimed within one month or prizemoney cheques not presented to the bank within 8 weeks after the date of show shall become the property of the Gunnedah Show Society.



COMPETITOR CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others, including fellow competitors, officials, volunteers, judges and spectators.
- Do not act inappropriately or aggressively.
- 3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow competitors.
- 4. Conduct yourself in a responsible and appropriate manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- 5. Be courteous, kind and set a good example in dress and behaviour.
- 6. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
- 7. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of officials.
- 8. Accept responsibility for your actions.
- 9. Refrain from any form of harassment, bullying, abuse, violence, intimidation or vilification of others, including via the use of social media.
- 10. Use appropriately the facilities and equipment made available for the event.
- 11. Do not consume or be affected by alcohol or any other substances such that it impairs your judgement or the safety of yourself or others.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS & GUARDIANS

- 1. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment and development, not yours
- 2. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 3. Never ridicule or abuse your child or other participants.
- 4. Show appreciation and respect for the performance of all participants.
- 5. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons under the age of 18 years, as your words and actions are an example.
- 6. Encourage your child to participate always according to the rules.
- 7. Ensure appropriate levels of parent/guardian supervision of your child while they are participating.
- 8. Respect the officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- 9. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (including any participant, other parents/guardians, officials and administrators).
- 10. Be courteous in communications with administrators, officials, participants and other parents/guardians and teach your child to do the same.

- 3. All payments of events via global entries online. Only late entries to the six bar via the secretaries office will be accepted.
- 4. One horse may enter 2 height classes only
- 5. Jumping events conducted under E.A. rules.
- 6. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the programme.
- 7. E.A. approved helmet must be worn and tagged.
- 8. Correct showjumping attire must be worn for all official competitions.



- Judges Decision is Final. Protests and complaints received by Secretary on the day of the Show. Protests to be made within 1/2 hour after Ticket of Award is issued accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00, which will be forfeited if proved frivolous.
- It is the condition of entry at this show that all horses and their handlers, and/or riders competing, compete on the understanding that drug testing may be carried out.
- An Official Measurer will be on the ground. If any disputes, horses must be measured by appointed measurer. EFA official Height Certificates are accepted.
- Competitors entering in events which clash must supply another rider. Rings will
 not wait for competitors in other classes. Please see ring stewards or ring Horse
 Convenor.
- No person other than Judges, Committeemen, Stewards, Riders and Drivers of exhibits allowed inside Ring during Show Days.
- All electrical cords must be tested and tagged. Random spot checks will be conducted.
- Stallions cannot compete in Hacking and Riding Classes, Special Classes accepted.
- Any alterations to programme will be posted on the Horse Notice Board at the Marshalling Yards. Competitors are requested to keep watching the Notice Board.
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to ascertain the time scheduled for his/her events and be ready. Competitors who are late may be refused entry to the Ring.
